Scotte R. Hartronft, MD, MBA, FACP, FACHE



Dr. Scotte R. Hartronft, MD, MBA, FACHE has been serving as the Acting Executive Director, Office of Geriatrics and Extended Care (10NC4) in the Veterans Health Administration since November 27, 2018.

Dr. Hartronft, who is a US Army Veteran, has been the Chief of Staff of VA Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System (VAGLAHCS) since April 2016. VAGLAHCS is a Level 1a facility but also is the most clinically complex system in the VA, has the largest educational training programs in the VA, has a research program that is within the VA's 5 largest. Dr. Hartronft has also been a Clinical Professor and Associate Dean at the UCLA David Geffen School of Medicine.

Dr. Hartronft formerly served as the Deputy Chief of Staff for the VA Puget Sound Health Care System from 2011 to April 2016 and as the Associate Chief of Staff for Geriatrics and Extended Care at the South Texas Veterans Health Care System (STVHCS) from 2006 through 2011.

Dr. Hartronft received his medical degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine and completed his Master of Business Administration degree at the University of Washington's Foster School of Business.

After graduating medical school, Dr. Hartronft went onto active duty in the U.S. Army and completed both an internship and residency in Internal Medicine and completed the joint VA/DoD Geriatric Medicine fellowship program. He served on active duty in the US Army for eight years until he left in 2006 as a field grade officer.

He is board certified in Internal Medicine, Geriatric Medicine and Hospice and Palliative Medicine. He is also a Certified Physician Executive (CPE) by the Certifying Commission in Medical Management, a Fellow of the American College of Physicians (FACP) and a Fellow in the American College of Health Care Executives (FACHE).
