Scott Farmer is the executive director of the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency, a self-supporting public agency with the mission to create affordable housing opportunities for North Carolinians whose needs are not met by the market. Prior to joining the Agency, he worked in mortgage servicing.

He was previously a member of the National Association of Home Builders Housing Credit Work Group and the N.C. Sustainable Communities Task Force.
