Patrick N. Findlay was appointed in November 2022 as the Executive Director of the Office of Congressional Workplace Rights (OCWR), the office established by the Congressional Accountability Act to administer workplace protections in the legislative branch.

Immediately prior to joining the OCWR, Mr. Findlay was the General Counsel of the National Security Division of the U.S. Department of Justice. Among his other prior roles in government, he served as an Associate General Counsel of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, as Senior Counselor in the Office of Congressional and Intergovernmental Affairs at the U.S. Department of Labor, and as Investigative Counsel for the U.S. House Committee on Education and Labor.

He earned his law degree from the University of Chicago Law School and his undergraduate degree from the University of Texas at Austin.
