The Internet Archive, a 501(c)(3) non-profit, is building a digital library of Internet sites and other cultural artifacts in digital form. It holds over 150 petabytes of data including:

- 835 billion web pages
- 44 million books and texts
- 15 million audio recordings (including 255,000 live concerts)
- 10.6 million videos (including 2.6 million Television News programs)
- 4.8 million images
- 1 million software programs

Served as Head of Operations at Atoms, a footwear company founded by Waqas and Sidra Ali, where I oversaw all aspects of operations from purchasing to production and delivery. In 2020, I led the company's pivot to produce nearly one million reusable masks, recognized by [WSJ](#) for best-in-class material, with a one-for-one donation model benefiting organizations such as the Know Your Rights Camp and NYC public schools. I also managed collaborations with artists and public figures, including Tan France, and helped scale operations from a San Francisco basement to the Brooklyn Navy Yard, supporting growth to over \$10 million in annual revenue within three years.

The Internet Archive, a 501(c)(3) non-profit, the Work Transition Program which I supervised was focused on reintroducing former addicts into the workforce.

- Co-developed the Work Transition Pilot Program (WTP). Created processes, structure, key performance metrics, tracked expenses and reported on program budget, instructed participants in basic safety and health practices.
- Managed, trained and enabled personal and professional development of WTP participants.
- Provided re-entry into the workforce training, this included how to write a resume, how to interview, and constant feedback on performance.
- Over 80% of participants graduated into full time career jobs.
- Ran on-site warehouse and scanning center operations
