Martin J. Crane was appointed in January 2024 as the Executive Director of the Office of Congressional Workplace Rights (OCWR), which was established by Congress to administer the Congressional Accountability Act in the legislative branch. Before his appointment, Mr. Crane had served as an OCWR Deputy Executive Director since 2017.

Prior to joining the OCWR, Mr. Crane served as Chief Counsel to the Chairman of the U.S. Merit Systems Protection Board. Additionally, he spent over 15 years practicing labor and employment law in the private sector. Mr. Crane earned his law degree from the George Washington University Law School and his undergraduate degree from Eastern Michigan University.
