
## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1960 OFFERED BY MR. SHUSTER OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the appropriate place in subtitle C of title II, insert the following:

1	SEC. 2 PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS FOR MEADS
2	PROGRAM.
3	(a) Prohibition.—None of the funds authorized to
4	be appropriated by this Act or otherwise made available
5	for fiscal year 2014 for the Department of Defense may
6	be obligated or expended for the medium extended air de-
7	fense system.
8	(b) Harvesting Technology.—
9	(1) Notice and wait.—The Secretary of De-
10	fense may not carry out actions described in para-
11	graph (2) until a period of 120 days has elapsed fol-
12	lowing the date on which the Secretary notifies the
13	congressional defense committees of the plans of the
14	Secretary to carry out such actions.
15	(2) ACTIONS DESCRIBED.—Actions described in
16	this paragraph are actions relating to harvesting
17	technology of the medium extended air defense sys-
18	tem.
19	(c) Report.—

1	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than February 15,
2	2014, the Secretary of the Army shall submit to the
3	congressional defense committees a report on the op-
4	portunities to harvest technology of the medium ex-
5	tended air defense system to modernize the various
6	air and missile defense systems and integrated archi-
7	tecture of the Army, based on the report required by
8	section 226 of the National Defense Authorization
9	Act for Fiscal Year 2013 (Public Law 112–239; 126
10	Stat. 1678).
11	(2) MATTERS INCLUDED.—The report under
12	paragraph (1) shall include the following:
13	(A) A review of current Army and joint re-
14	quirements to which any harvested technology
15	of the medium extended air defense system
16	might be applied.
17	(B) The timeline of the Secretary for com-
18	pletion of an analysis of alternatives to tech-
19	nologies and systems being considered for har-
20	vesting.
21	(C) An overview of the planned acquisition
22	strategy for any major systems being considered
23	for harvesting and for insertion into the inte-
24	grated air and missile defense architecture.



- 1 (d) Application.—The prohibition in subsection (a)
- 2 may not be superseded except by a provision of law that
- 3 specifically supersedes, repeals, or modifies such sub-
- 4 section.
