Strike “In section 2901(a), strike ‘\$247,400,000’ and insert ‘\$186,400,000’”.

Page 1, beginning on line 1, strike “(d) LIMITATION” and all that follows through “an assessment that includes” and insert the following:

1 (d) BRIEFING ON INFRASTRUCTURE TO SUPPORT
2 JOINT TASK FORCE, GUANTANAMO.—

3 (1) BRIEFING REQUIRED.—The Secretary of
4 Defense shall brief the congressional defense com-
5 mittees on

Page 4, beginning on line 16, strike paragraph (2) and insert the following:

6 (2) PRESIDENTIAL PLAN.—Not later than 120
7 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
8 President shall submit to the congressional defense
9 committees a plan describing each of the following:
10 (A) The locations to which the President
11 seeks to transfer individuals detained at Guan-

1 tanamo who have been identified for continued
2 detention or prosecution.

3 (B) The individuals detained at Guanta-
4 namo who the President seeks to transfer to
5 overseas locations, the overseas locations to
6 which the President seeks to transfer such indi-
7 viduals, and the conditions under which the
8 President would transfer such individuals to
9 such locations.

10 (C) The proposal of the President for the
11 detention and treatment of individuals captured
12 overseas in the future who are suspected of
13 being terrorists.

14 (D) The proposal of the President regard-
15 ing the disposition of the individuals detained at
16 the detention facility at Parwan, Afghanistan,
17 who have been identified as enduring security
18 threats to the United States.

19 (E) For any location in the United States
20 to which the President seeks to transfer such
21 an individual, estimates of each of the following
22 costs:

23 (i) The costs of constructing infra-
24 structure to support detention operations
25 or prosecution at such location.

- 1 (ii) The costs of facility repair,
- 2 sustainment, maintenance, and operation
- 3 of all infrastructure supporting detention
- 4 operations or prosecution at such location.
- 5 (iii) The costs of military personnel,
- 6 civilian personnel, and contractors associ-
- 7 ated with the detention operations or pros-
- 8 ecution at such location, including any
- 9 costs likely to be incurred by other Federal
- 10 departments or agencies or State or local
- 11 governments.
- 12 (iv) Any other costs associated with
- 13 supporting the detention operations or
- 14 prosecution at such location.
