At the end of title X, add the following:

1 SEC. 10____. LIMITATION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR 2 DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN LANDMINES.

3 (a) LIMITATION.—Except as provided under sub-4 section (b), none of the funds authorized to be appro-5 priated by this Act or otherwise made available for fiscal 6 year 2016 for the Department of Defense may be obli-7 gated or expended for the destruction of anti-personnel 8 landmines of the United States (as defined in the an-9 nouncement of the President on September 23, 2014) 10 until—

- (1) the Secretary of Defense publishes a comprehensive study on—
- 13 (A) the tactical and operational effects of
 14 a ban on such landmines; and
 15 (B) the current state of research into oper16 ational alternatives to such landmines;
 17 (2) such alternatives are specifically authorized
- 18 by law and provided appropriations;

(4) members of the Armed Forces of the United
 States and allies of the United States are trained in
 the use of such alternatives; and

(5) the Secretary certifies to the congressional 4 5 defense committees that the replacement of such 6 landmines by such alternatives will not endanger 7 members of the Armed Forces of the United States 8 or allies of the United States or pose any operational 9 challenges and that adequate stockpiles and manu-10 facturing capacity exists to meet the needs of the 11 Armed Forces of the United States and allies of the 12 United States in current deployments and antici-13 pated contingencies.

(b) EXCEPTION FOR SAFETY.—The limitation under
subsection (a) shall not apply to any anti-personnel land
mine that the Secretary certifies has become unsafe or
poses a safety risk if not demilitarized or destroyed.
