
Amendment to H.R. 1735 Offered by Mr. Takai of Hawaii

At the end of subtitle A of title VI, add the following new section:

SEC. 602. PROHIBITION ON PER DIEM ALLOWANCE REDUC TIONS BASED ON THE DURATION OF TEM PORARY DUTY ASSIGNMENT OR CIVILIAN
 TRAVEL.

5 (a) MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES.—Sec-6 tion 474(d)(3) of title 37, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence: "The 7 Secretaries concerned shall not alter the amount of the 8 9 per diem allowance, or the maximum amount of reim-10 bursement, for a locality based on the duration of the temporary duty assignment of a member of the uniformed 11 12 services in the locality.".

(b) CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES.—Section 5702(a)(2) of
title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
end the following new sentence: "The Secretary of the Department of Defense shall not alter the amount of the per
diem allowance, or the maximum amount of reimbursement, for a locality based on the duration of the travel
of an employee of the Department in the locality.".



1 (c) REPEAL OF POLICY AND REGULATIONS.—The 2 policy, and any regulations issued pursuant to such policy, 3 implemented by the Secretary of the Department of De-4 fense on November 1, 2014, with respect to reductions in 5 per diem allowances based on duration of temporary duty 6 assignment or civilian travel shall have no force or effect.

Section 4103 of Division D, relating to Operation and Maintenance, Administration and Servicewide Activities, reduce the amount for the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Line 300, by \$24,000,000.

Increase amounts in section 4301 of Division D, relating to Operation and Maintenance, and section 4401 of Division D, relating to Military Personnel, by \$24,000,000, to reflect the amendments made by section 602.

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
