

AMENDMENT  
OFFERED BY MR. TURNER TO THE AMENDMENT  
OFFERED BY MR. LAMBORN

In subsection (a)(4) of the section proposed to be inserted by the amendment, strike “is the only museum in the United States that exists to exclusively preserve” and insert “exists to help preserve”.

Strike subsection (b) of the section proposed to be inserted by the amendment.

At the end of the section proposed to be inserted by the amendment, add the following new subsection:

1       (b) CONDITIONS ON RECOGNITION OF AMERICA'S  
2 NATIONAL WORLD WAR II AVIATION MUSEUM.—The  
3 Secretary of the Air Force, Secretary of the Navy, and  
4 Secretary of the Army shall—

5           (1) each provide a briefing to the Committees  
6 on Armed Services of the House of Representatives  
7 and the Senate evaluating the suitability of the mu-  
8 seum for recognition as a national museum; and

9           (2) each certify to such Committees that the  
10 museum is suitable for such recognition.

(c) ELEMENTS OF CERTIFICATION - The Secretary of the Air Force, Secretary of the Navy, and Secretary of the Army shall provide certification under

1 section (b)(2) only if each certifies that each of the fol-

2 lowing is correct:

3 (1) The museum possesses the infrastructure  
4 necessary to maintain and preserve military cultural  
5 resources.

6 (2) The museum is accredited.

7 (3) The museum prevents the private use of  
8 any item donated to the museum.

9 (4) The museum applies industry standards for  
10 the preservation of military cultural resources.

11 (5) The museum employs sufficient staff,  
12 trained to industry standards, to ensure the preser-  
13 vation of military cultural resources.
