Special Operations Forces Education Briefing


The committee remains concerned that high operational tempo and dwell times may not afford U.S. Special Operations Forces appropriate time for enrollment in Department of Defense (DoD) education programs such as the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) and the Post 9-11 GI Bill. Therefore, the Committee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives directs a briefing from the Commander, U.S. Special Operations Command, not later than September 16, 2016, on the following:

- 1. The number of U.S. Special Operations Forces active and reserve personnel currently enrolled in TAP and the Post 9-11 GI Bill;
- 2. The number of SOF active and reserve enrolled in these programs over the past five years;
- 3. Percentage of SOF personnel active and reserve enrolled in these programs as compared to general purpose forces.
 - 4. Any additional elements the Commander deems relevant.

At the end of subtitle B of title XXVIII, add the following new section:

9	"(a) Allotment of Space and Provision of
10	SERVICES AUTHORIZED.—Upon application by a WIC of-
11	fice, the Secretary of a military department may allot
12	space on a military installation under the jurisdiction of
13	the Secretary to the WIC office without charge for rent
14	or services if the Secretary determines that—
15	"(1) the WIC office provides or will provide
16	services solely to members of the armed forces as-
17	signed to the installation, civilian employees of the
18	Department of Defense employed at the installation,
19	or dependents of such members or employees;



1	"(2) space is available on the installation;
2	"(3) operation of the WIC office will not hinder
3.	military mission requirements; and
4	"(4) the security situation at the installation
5	permits the presence of a non-Federal entity on the
6	installation.
7	"(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
8	"(1) The term 'services' includes the provision
9	of lighting, heating, cooling, and electricity.
10	"(2) The term 'WIC office' means a local agen-
11	cy (as defined in subsection (b)(6) of section 17 of
12	the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1786))
13	that participates in the special supplemental nutri-
14	tion program for women, infants, and children under
15	such section.".
16	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
17	at the beginning of chapter 152 of title 10, United States
18	Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
