## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 6395 OFFERED BY MR. KHANNA OF CALIFORNIA

At the appropriate place in title XII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 12 . PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT FOR MILITARY

2	PARTICIPATION AGAINST THE HOUTHIS.
3	(a) Prohibition Relating to Support.—None of
4	the funds authorized to be appropriated or otherwise made
5	available by this Act may be made available to provide
6	United States logistical support to the Saudi-led coali-
7	tion's operations against the Houthis in Yemen for coali-
8	tion strikes, specifically by providing maintenance or
9	transferring spare parts to coalition members flying war-
10	planes engaged in anti-Houthi bombings for coalition
11	strikes.
12	(b) Prohibition Relating to Military Partici-
13	PATION.—None of the funds authorized to be appropriated
14	or otherwise made available by this Act may be made
15	available for any civilian or military personnel of the De-
16	partment of Defense or contractors of the Department to
17	command, coordinate, participate in the movement of, or
18	accompany the regular or irregular military forces of the
19	Saudi and United Arab Emirates-led coalition forces en-

- 1 gaged in hostilities against the Houthis in Yemen or in
- 2 situations in which there exists an imminent threat that
- 3 such coalition forces become engaged in such hostilities,
- 4 unless and until the President has obtained specific statu-
- 5 tory authorization, in accordance with section 8(a) of the
- 6 War Powers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1547(a)).
- 7 (c) Rule of Construction.—The prohibitions
- 8 under this section may not be construed to apply with re-
- 9 spect to United States Armed Forces engaged in oper-
- 10 ations directed at al-Qaeda or associated forces.
