9	retary of Defense shall submit to the congressional

11	source content of any procurement carried out in
12	connection with major defense acquisition programs.
13	(2) Information repository.—The Secretary
14	of Defense shall establish an information repository
15	for the collection and analysis of information related
16	to domestic source content that can be used for con-
17	tinuous data analysis and program management ac-
18	tivities.
19	(b) Enhanced Domestic Content Require-
20	MENT.—

1	(1) In general.—For purposes of chapter 83
2	of title 41, United States Code, manufactured arti-
3	cles, materials, or supplies procured in connection
4	with a major defense acquisition program shall be
5	deemed to be manufactured substantially all from
6	articles, materials, or supplies mined, produced, or
7	manufactured in the United States, if such compo-
8	nent articles, materials, or supplies—
9	(A) not later than October 1, 2021, com-
10	prise 75 percent of the manufactured articles,
11	materials, or supplies;
12	(B) not later than October 1, 2022, com-
13	prise 80 percent of the manufactured articles,
14	materials, or supplies;
15	(C) not later than October 1, 2023, com-
16	prise 85 percent of the manufactured articles,
17	materials, or supplies;
18	(D) not later than October 1, 2024, com-
19	prise 90 percent of the manufactured articles,
20	materials, or supplies;
21	(E) not later than October 1, 2025, com-
22	prise 95 percent of the manufactured articles,
23	materials, or supplies; and

1	(F) not later than October 1, 2026, com-
2	prise 100 percent of the manufactured articles,
3	materials, or supplies.
4	(2) Waiver.—Before Milestone A approval (as
5	defined in section 2366a(d) of title 10, United
6	States Code) is granted for a major defense acquisi-
7	tion program, the Secretary of Defense shall deter-
8	mine whether or not to grant a waiver of the re-
9	quirements of paragraph (1).
10	(3) Effective date.—The domestic content
11	requirement under paragraph (1) applies to con-
12	tracts entered into on or after October 1, 2021.
13	(c) Major Defense Acquisition Program De-
14	FINED.—In this section, the term "major defense acquisi-
15	tion program" has the meaning given in section 2430 of
16	title 10, United States Code.
