AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7900 OFFERED BY MRS. HARTZLER OF MISSOURI

At the appropriate place in title VII, insert the following new section:

1	SEC. 7 PROHIBITION ON DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE
2	COVID-19 VACCINE REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-
3	DIVIDUALS WITH NATURAL IMMUNITY.
4	(a) Prohibition.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5	sion of law, the Secretary of Defense may not require a
6	naturally immune individual to receive a vaccine for
7	COVID-19.
8	(b) Two-year Natural Immunity Period.—An in-
9	dividual shall be deemed to be a naturally immune indi-
10	vidual for the period of time beginning on the date that
11	is 14 days after the date on which the individual receives
12	a laboratory confirmation of a COVID-19 infection and
13	ending on the date that is two years after the date of such
14	receipt.
15	(c) Testing.—Following the date on which an indi-
16	vidual ceases to be a naturally immune individual, the Sec-
17	retary of Defense may not require the individual to receive
18	a COVID-19 vaccine until such time as the Secretary fur-

- 2 antibody protection against COVID-19.
- 3 (d) Naturally Immune Individual Defined.—In
- 4 this section, the term "naturally immune individual"
- 5 means an individual who has sustained antibody protec-
- 6 tion against COVID-19 (as demonstrated by detectable
- 7 neutralizing antibodies) resulting from a prior COVID-
- 8 19 infection.
