

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2670**  
**OFFERED BY MR. FALLON OF TEXAS**

At the appropriate place in title XVIII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 18 \_\_\_\_ . LIMITATION ON FUNDS RELATING TO FEDERAL**  
2 **CONTRACTOR DISCLOSURE OF GREENHOUSE**  
3 **GAS EMISSIONS AND CLIMATE-RELATED FI-**  
4 **NANCIAL RISK.**

5 (a) **LIMITATION.**—None of the funds authorized to  
6 be appropriated by this Act for the Department of Defense  
7 may be obligated or expended to recommend or require  
8 any entity submitting an offer for a Federal contract to  
9 disclose, as a condition of submitting the offer, any of the  
10 following information, or the existence of any of the fol-  
11 lowing information:

12 (1) Greenhouse gas emissions and climate-re-  
13 lated financial risk as described in the proposed rule  
14 titled “Federal Acquisition Regulation: Disclosure of  
15 Greenhouse Gas Emissions and Climate-Related Fi-  
16 nancial Risk” (87 Fed. Reg. 68312), or any sub-  
17 stantially similar rule.

18 (2) A greenhouse gas inventory or any other re-  
19 port on greenhouse gas emissions, including Scope 1

1 emissions, Scope 2 emissions, and Scope 3 emis-  
2 sions.

3 (3) Greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets  
4 for validation by any non-governmental organization,  
5 including the Science-Based Targets initiative.

6 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

7 (1) GREENHOUSE GAS.—The term “greenhouse  
8 gas” means—

9 (A) carbon dioxide;

10 (B) methane;

11 (C) nitrous oxide;

12 (D) nitrogen trifluoride;

13 (E) hydrofluorocarbons;

14 (F) perfluorocarbons; or

15 (G) sulfur hexafluoride.

16 (2) GREENHOUSE GAS INVENTORY.—The term  
17 “greenhouse gas inventory” means a quantified list  
18 of an entity’s annual greenhouse gas emissions.

19 (3) SCOPE 1 EMISSIONS.—The term “Scope 1  
20 emissions” means, with respect to an entity, direct  
21 greenhouse gas emissions that are emitted from  
22 sources that are owned or controlled by the entity.

23 (4) SCOPE 2 EMISSIONS.—The term “Scope 2  
24 emissions” means, with respect to an entity, indirect  
25 greenhouse gas emissions that are—

1 (A) associated with the generation of elec-  
2 tricity, heating and cooling, or steam, when  
3 such electricity, heating and cooling, or steam is  
4 purchased or acquired for the entity's own con-  
5 sumption; and

6 (B) emitted from sources other than  
7 sources that are owned or controlled by the en-  
8 tity.

9 (5) SCOPE 3 EMISSIONS.—The term “Scope 3  
10 emissions” means, with respect to an entity, indirect  
11 greenhouse gas emissions, other than Scope 2 emis-  
12 sions, that are—

13 (A) a consequence of the operations of the  
14 entity; and

15 (B) emitted from sources other than  
16 sources that are owned or controlled by the en-  
17 tity.
