## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8070 OFFERED BY MR. JACKSON OF TEXAS

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1	SEC STUDY AND REPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF
2	NAVAL BLOCKADES OF SHIPMENTS OF FOS-
3	SIL FUELS TO CHINA IN EVENT OF ARMED
4	CONFLICT.
5	(a) Study and Report.—Not later than 180 days
6	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
7	of Defense shall submit to Congress a report that contains
8	the findings of a study on the feasibility of implementing
9	one or more naval blockades of shipments of fossil fuels
10	to China in the event of an armed conflict between the
11	United States and China. Such report shall include—
12	(1) a description of—
13	(A) the requirements for such a blockade
14	to effectively block such shipments;
15	(B) methods China could use to ship fossil
16	fuels using air and land routes after such a
17	blockade is implemented; and
18	(C) for each waterway specified in clauses
19	(i) through (iv) of paragraph (2)(A), how such

1	a blockade would be implemented in such wa-
2	terway; and
3	(2) an assessment of—
4	(A) the suitability of strategic waterways
5	in the proximity of China as a location for such
6	a blockade, including—
7	(i) the Strait of Malacca;
8	(ii) the Taiwan Strait;
9	(iii) the Sunda Strait;
10	(iv) the South China Sea; and
11	(v) the East China Sea; and
12	(B) the capability of China to satisfy needs
13	for fossil fuels in China after such a blockade
14	is implemented through methods that include—
15	(i) the use of existing stockpiles of
16	fossil fuels;
17	(ii) the rationing of fossil fuels; and
18	(iii) the reliance on existing or
19	planned cross-border oil and gas pipelines
20	to ship fossil fuels.
21	(b) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)
22	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
23	a classified annex.
