

MR. SCOTT BOUSUM, LEGISLATIVE DIRECTOR

Scott Bousum is the Legislative Director at the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States (EANGUS). As the Legislative Director, Scott works with the enlisted state associations to advocate on behalf of Guardsmen on Capitol Hill, specifically on issues related to compensation, retirement, and National Guard weapons and equipment programs. Before joining EANGUS, Scott was the Director of National Security Policy and Procurement Policy at TechAmerica, a technology industry association. While at TechAmerica, he focused on supply chain security, regulatory affairs, and the federal acquisition process. Prior to joining TechAmerica, Scott worked on the House Armed Services Committee from 2009 to 2013, supporting the Tactical Air and Land Forces Subcommittee. Scott is from Oklahoma and worked for former U.S. Senator Tom Coburn of Oklahoma. He is a graduate of the University of Tulsa and received his Masters' degree in National Security Strategic Studies from the United States Naval War College.
