Mr. Ludwigson is a Director in the Contracting and National Security Acquisitions (CNSA) team and has worked for the United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) for over 20 years having joined GAO in 1998. His work with CNSA currently spans a variety of acquisition programs including DOD space systems, DOD strategic nuclear systems including NC3 and GBSD, Army modernization, as well as several large individual acquisition programs including the F-35 Joint Strike Fighter, CH-53K, Amphibious Combat Vehicle, and KC-46. In addition, Mr. Ludwigson has led examinations of advanced technologies including hypersonic weapons systems, artificial intelligence, and alternative position, navigation and timing. Prior to joining CNSA, Mr. Ludwigson worked on energy supply and demand, energy markets, and federal energy research and development, among other things. During his time at GAO he has contributed to GAO's duplication, fragmentation and potential cost savings reports and the high risk reports. Mr. Ludwigson received numerous accolades in recognition of his contributions to GAO and Congress.
