Mr. Ludwigson is a Director in the Contracting and National Security Acquisitions (CNSA) team and has worked for the United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) for over 20 years. His work with CNSA currently spans a variety of acquisition programs including DOD space systems, DOD strategic nuclear systems including NC3 and GBSD, missile defense, as well as several large individual acquisition programs including the F-35 Joint Strike Fighter, CH-53K, and KC-46. In addition, Mr. Ludwigson has led teams examining advanced technologies and weapons system development including hypersonic weapons systems, artificial intelligence, directed energy, and alternative position, navigation and timing. Prior to joining CNSA, Mr. Ludwigson led numerous examinations of science and technology, energy market development, and regulatory oversight relating to a wide range of energy sources and uses. During his time at GAO he has contributed to GAO's duplication, fragmentation and potential cost savings reports and the high-risk reports.
