

Martin C. Faga

Former President and Chief Executive Officer, MITRE Corporation



Martin Faga retired as president, chief executive officer of MITRE on June 30, 2006. He was a member of the MITRE Board of Trustees until 2012.

Before joining MITRE, Mr. Faga served from 1989 until 1993 as Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Space, where he was responsible for overall supervision of Air Force space matters. At the same time, he served as Director of the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO), responsible to the secretary of defense and the Director of Central Intelligence for the development, acquisition and operation of all U.S. satellite reconnaissance programs.

Mr. Faga is a Fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Association of Former Intelligence Officers. He served from 2006-2009 on the President's Intelligence Advisory Board and was a member of the Public Interest Declassification Board from 2006 to 2014.

Mr. Faga serves on the Board of Directors of Orbital ATK, is Chairman of the Board of Thomson Reuters Special Services and is a Proxy Holder at Inmarsat Government. He served on the boards of Electronic Data Systems from 2006 to 2008, GeoEye from 2006 to 2013, and DigitalGlobe from 2013 to 2015.

Mr. Faga received master and bachelor of science degrees in electrical engineering from Lehigh University in 1964 and 1963.
