Collection restrictions with respect to Fed-7 eral student loans 8 "(a) PROHIBITION ON COLLECTING FROM BOR-ROWERS BELOW CERTAIN INCOME GUIDELINES.—A debt 9 collector may not attempt to collect a debt with respect 10 to a Federal student loan during any period of time when 11 the borrower of such loan would not be required to make 12 a payment under an income-driven repayment plan. 13 14 "(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section: 15 "(1) FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN.—The term
