## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Homeless Assistance5 Act of 2019".

## SEC. 2. LIMITED AUTHORITY TO SHARE INFORMATION RE GARDING HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS AND FAM ILIES WITH APPROPRIATE ENTITY WITHIN THE CONTINUUM OF CARE.

5 Section 2 of the United States Housing Act of 1937
6 (42 U.S.C. 1437) is amended by adding at the end the
7 following new subsection:

8 "(c) LIMITED AUTHORITY TO SHARE INFORMATION 9 REGARDING HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES WITH APPROPRIATE ENTITY WITHIN CONTINUUM OF 10 CARE.—Notwithstanding section 904 of the Stewart B. 11 McKinney Homeless Assistance Amendments Act of 1988 12 (42 U.S.C. 3544), a public housing agency may disclose, 13 to the entity designated by the collaborative applicant 14 within which the jurisdiction of the public housing agency 15 is located and any relevant State and local government 16 agencies, information regarding individuals and families 17 who are homeless (as such term is used in section 103) 18 19 of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 20 U.S.C. 11302)) or at risk of homelessness (as such term 21 is used in section 401 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 1360)), but 22 only-

23 "(1) for the purpose of facilitating the identi24 fication, assessment, and linkage of housing and
25 supportive services for such individuals and families

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- to ensure continuity of care, to the extent allowable
   under State Law;
- "(2) if the public housing agency takes appropriate measures to ensure that the privacy of the individuals and families is protected and that the information is used only for the purpose described in
  paragraph (1); and
- 8 "(3) if the public housing agency takes appro9 priate measures to ensure clients' information and
  10 confidentiality is protected pursuant to section
  11 41411(c)(4) of the Violence Against Women Act of
  12 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12491(c)(4)), and any regulations
  13 promulgated pursuant to such section.".
