

Jonathan McKernan has been a member of the FDIC's Board of Directors since January 5, 2023. He previously served as an advisor to Ranking Member Pat Toomey on the staff of the Senate Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs, at the Federal Housing Finance Agency, at the Department of the Treasury, and to Senator Bob Corker.

Mr. McKernan was a co-chairman of the Special Review Committee established by the Board of Directors to oversee an independent third-party review into allegations of sexual harassment and interpersonal misconduct at the FDIC, as well as issues relating to the workplace culture at the agency. That report was released on May 7, 2024.

Prior to his government service, Mr. McKernan was an attorney in private practice focused on matters under the banking and consumer financial laws.

Mr. McKernan holds a Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts in economics from the University of Tennessee and a Juris Doctor with High Honors from the Duke University School of Law.
