- 3 SECTION 1. GAO STUDY TO DETERMINE PROXIMITY OF
- 4 HOUSING TO SUPERFUND SITES.
- 5 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United
- 6 States shall carry out a study to identify how many resi-
- 7 dential dwelling units, and how many dwelling units in

- 2 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.
- 3 1437a(B))), are located within one mile of a site that is
- 4 included on the National Priorities List pursuant to sec-
- 5 tion 105 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response,
- 6 Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42 U.S.C.
- 7 9605).
- 8 (b) Report.—Not later than the expiration of the
- 9 6-month period beginning on the date of the enactment
- 10 of this Act, the Comptroller General shall submit a report
- 11 to the Congress identifying, for each site referred to in
- 12 subsection (a), how many residential dwelling units, and
- 13 how many dwelling units in public housing, are located
- 14 within one mile of such site.
