Page 19, beginning on line 21, strike “, and the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection”.

Page 40, strike lines 6 through 16.

Page 41, strike lines 4 through 8.

Page 41, strike lines 15 through 19.

Page 75, strike line 22 and all that follows through page 76, line 2.

Page 76, beginning on line 11, strike “—” and all that follows through “(A) means” on line 12 and insert “means”.

Page 76, line 16, strike “; and” and insert “;”; and”.

Page 76, strike lines 17 through 19.

Page 76, line 25, add “and” at the end.

Page 77, strike lines 1 through 4.

Page 95, beginning on line 13, strike “—” and all that follows through “(i) the” on line 14 and insert “the”.

Page 95, line 15, strike “; and” and insert a period.

Page 95, strike lines 16 through 17.

Page 99, strike lines 9 through 11.

Page 101, strikes lines 4 through 5.

7 amended by striking “6.5” and inserting “12”.

8   **SEC. 902. SUPERVISION AND EXAMINATION.**

9           The Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection shall,  
10 immediate after the date of enactment of this Act, resume  
11 the Bureau’s supervision and examination of insured de-  
12 pository institutions and insured credit unions with total  
13 assets of more than \$10,000,000,000 at the same fre-  
14 quency and with the same number of staff as the Bureau

1 was performing such supervisions and examinations in  
2 2024.
