**SUBJECT:** June 4, 2026, Full Committee Hearing: “Oversight of Prudential Regulators”

On Thursday, June 4, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., the House Committee on Financial Services will hold a hearing in Room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building, entitled “Oversight of Prudential Regulators.” The following witnesses will testify:

- **The Honorable Michelle Bowman**, Vice Chair for Supervision, Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System
- **The Honorable Jonathan Gould**, Comptroller, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency
- **The Honorable Kyle Hauptman**, Chairman, National Credit Union Administration
- **The Honorable Travis Hill**, Chairman, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation

Section 1108 of the *Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act* amended the *Federal Reserve Act* to create the position of Vice Chair for Supervision of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, and to require the Vice Chair for Supervision to testify before the Committee at semiannual hearings.<sup>1</sup> The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Office of the Comptroller of the Currency, and the National Credit Union Administration are not subject to the same statutory testimony requirements. This hearing will examine supervisory and regulatory developments, rulemakings, and activities of the prudential regulators.
