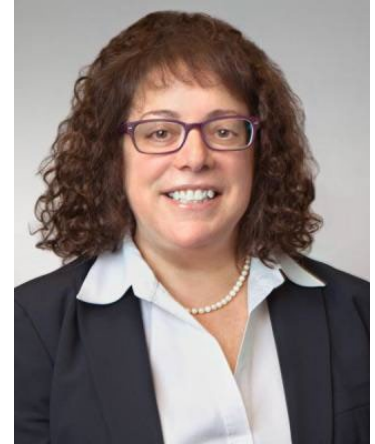


Ms. Elizabeth Heck, Chairman, President and CEO of Greater New York Insurance Companies

Elizabeth Heck is Chairman, President, and Chief Executive Officer of Greater New York Insurance Companies. Ms. Heck first joined GNY in 2001 as the company's Corporate Controller and subsequently served as its Chief Financial Officer before being named President in August 2010. She assumed the role of Chief Executive Officer in January 2015 and Chairman of the Board in March 2020. Prior to joining GNY, Ms. Heck served in senior financial roles at GRE Insurance Group (subsidiary of Guardian Royal Exchange) and the Home Insurance Company. She began her career at Ernst & Young where her focus was financial services.



Ms. Heck earned a Bachelor of Arts in Accounting and Finance from Franklin & Marshall College. She also completed executive training at the Wharton School of Business and holds a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) designation. She serves on the Board of several insurance associations, including the Insurance Brokers Association of New York, New York Insurance Association (past Chair), American Society of Workers' Compensation Professionals (Chair), New York Compensation Insurance Rating Board (past Chair), and the National Association of Mutual Insurance Companies (Chair and Vice Chair). She currently serves as a member on the Federal Insurance Office's Advisory Committee on Risk-Sharing Mechanisms.
