Subject: April 8, 2025, Oversight and Investigations Subcommittee Hearing: “Decades of Dysfunction: Restoring Accountability at HUD.”

On Tuesday, April 8, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. EDT, the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations will hold a hearing in room 2128 of the Rayburn House Office Building, entitled “Decades of Dysfunction: Restoring Accountability at HUD.” The following witness will testify:

- Mr. Stephen M. Begg, Acting Inspector General, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The hearing will examine the persistent waste, fraud, and mismanagement within the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This hearing will underscore the critical need for congressional oversight and review by the Department of Government Oversight and Efficiency (DOGE) to ensure transparency, accountability, and operational effectiveness within the agency. The Committee will hear the testimony of the Acting Inspector General at HUD to better understand the depths of waste, fraud, and mismanagement at the agency, while also hearing potential corrective measures.

Attached Legislation

1. **H.R. 225, HUD Transparency Act of 2025:** Similar to H.R.7280 in the 118th Congress, this bill would require the Office of Inspector General from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to testify before Congress annually.
