**A BILL**

To extend the authority of the Export-Import Bank of the  
United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Export-Import Bank  
5 Reauthorization Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY OF EXPORT-IMPORT**  
7 **BANK OF THE UNITED STATES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 7 of the Export-Import  
9 Bank Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635f) is amended by strik-  
10 ing “2026” and inserting “2031”.

1 (b) AGGREGATE LOAN, GUARANTEE, AND INSUR-  
2 ANCE AUTHORITY.—Section 6(a)(2) of the Export-Import  
3 Bank Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635e(a)(2)) is amended by  
4 striking “2027” and inserting “2031”.

5 (c) PROGRAM ON CHINA AND TRANSFORMATIONAL  
6 EXPORTS.—Section 2(l)(3)(C) of the Export-Import Bank  
7 Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635(l)(3)(C)) is amended by strik-  
8 ing “December 31, 2026” and all that follows and insert-  
9 ing “December 31, 2031.”.

10 (d) INCLUSION OF NUCLEAR ENERGY.—Section  
11 2(l)(1)(B)(vi) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945 (12  
12 U.S.C. 635(l)(1)(B)(vi)) is amended by inserting “and nu-  
13 clear” after “renewable”.

14 (e) REPORTING ON FINANCING RELATED TO  
15 CHINA.—Section 408(e)(1) of division I of the Further  
16 Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020 (12 U.S.C. 635  
17 note) is amended by striking “2026” and inserting  
18 “2031”.

19 **SEC. 3. WORKING WITH ALLIES TO ENSURE THE COMPLI-**  
20 **ANCE OF CHINA WITH OECD STANDARDS.**

21 (a) IN GENERAL.—Within 180 days after the date  
22 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Treasury  
23 shall submit to the Committee on Financial Services of  
24 the House of Representatives and the Committee on

1 Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate a de-  
2 tailed strategy and timeline with respect to—

3 (1) strengthening United States advocacy and  
4 cooperation with appropriate allies and partners to  
5 seek to ensure substantial compliance by China with  
6 the financial terms and conditions of the OECD Ar-  
7 rangement on Officially Supported Export Credits;  
8 and

9 (2) achieving the goal described in section  
10 11(a)(1) of the Export-Import Bank Reauthorization  
11 Act of 2012.

12 (b) INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS ON EXPORT  
13 SUBSIDIES.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 11(a)(1) of the Ex-  
15 port-Import Bank Reauthorization Act of 2012 (12  
16 U.S.C. 635a–5(a)(1)) is amended—

17 (A) by striking “possible”; and

18 (B) by striking “Reform and Reauthoriza-  
19 tion Act of 2015,” and inserting “Reauthoriza-  
20 tion Act of 2026”.

21 (2) PROGRESS REPORT.—Section 11(e) of such  
22 Act (12 U.S.C. 635a–5(e)) is amended by striking  
23 “2019” and inserting “2036”.

24 (3) CONDUCT OF NEGOTIATIONS.—Section 11  
25 of such Act (12 U.S.C. 635a–5) is amended—

1 (A) in each of subsections (a) and (d), by  
2 striking “The President” and inserting “The  
3 Secretary of the Treasury, in consultation with  
4 the United States Trade Representative,”;

5 (B) in subsection (a), by inserting “, and  
6 endeavor to hold not less frequently than twice  
7 per year,” before “negotiations”;

8 (C) in each of subsections (b), (c), and (e),  
9 by striking “President” each place it appears  
10 and inserting “Secretary of the Treasury”; and

11 (D) in subsection (d), by inserting “, and  
12 endeavor to hold the negotiations not less fre-  
13 quently than twice per year” before the period.
