- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Small Business Inves-

2	THRESHOLD FOR CERTAIN INVESTMENT AD-
3	VISERS OF PRIVATE FUNDS.
4	Section 203(m) of the Investment Advisers Act of
5	1940 (15 U.S.C. 80b-3(m)) is amended by adding at the
6	end the following:
7	"(5) Inflation adjustment.—The Commis-
8	sion shall adjust the dollar amount described under
9	paragraph (1)—
10	"(A) upon enactment of this paragraph, to
11	reflect the change in the Consumer Price Index
12	for All Urban Consumers published by the Bu-
13	reau of Labor Statistics of the Department of
14	Labor between the date of enactment of the
15	Private Fund Investment Advisers Registration
16	Act of 2010 and the date of enactment of this
17	paragraph; and
18	"(B) annually thereafter, to reflect the
19	change in the Consumer Price Index for All
20	Urban Consumers published by the Bureau of
21	Labor Statistics of the Department of Labor.".
