Jennifer Shaw is the Executive Director of the Public Investors Advocate Bar Association (“PIABA”). She has served in that role since 2022. In her role as Executive Director, Ms. Shaw works with the Board of PIABA to advocate for the interests of investors in matters of securities fraud and other issues related to securities laws and regulations. She works on behalf of PIABA and its members to develop position papers, press releases, and legislative and regulatory comments, as well as planning and moderating conferences, seminars, and CLE sessions on matters of securities regulation and securities fraud.

Prior to working with PIABA, Ms. Shaw served as an enforcement attorney for the Oklahoma Department of Securities for over fifteen years. While at the Department she was primarily responsible for overseeing investor education outreach for the State of Oklahoma, as well as investigating and prosecuting individual cases of securities fraud. While at the Department Ms. Shaw also participated as a member of the North American Securities Administrators Association (“NASAA”) Senior Outreach Project Group where she was awarded the Outstanding Team Service Award.

In addition to her professional experience, Ms. Shaw also worked for the American Legion Auxiliary Oklahoma Girls State Program for 28 years, serving as Director and Education Director for over 20 of those years. As Director of Girls State Ms. Shaw managed a staff of over fifty volunteers, organized and supervised the annual Girls State conference offering promising Oklahoma female high school students the opportunity to learn about the workings of the Oklahoma State government, and worked closely with elected officials, State judges, public University leaders, and private donors, all on a volunteer basis.

Ms. Shaw received her Juris Doctor from the University of Oklahoma College of Law in 2005, where she served on the American Indian Law Review as Note Editor and Assistant Managing Editor, and her Bachelors of Business Administration from Southwestern Oklahoma State University in 2001 with a major in accounting.
