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Professor Scott's books include the law school textbook International Finance: Transactions, Policy and Regulation (24<sup>th</sup> ed. Foundation Press 2022); Connectedness and Contagion (M.I.T. Press 2016) and The Global Financial Crisis (Foundation Press 2009). He is the author of numerous journal articles and oped pieces in leading newspapers.

Professor Scott is also the Director of the Committee on Capital Markets Regulation, a bipartisan non-profit organization organized in 2006, dedicated to enhancing the competitiveness of U.S. capital markets and ensuring the stability of the U.S. financial system via research and advocacy.

He is also an independent director of MEMX, the Members Exhange. He is a past independent director of Lazard, Ltd. (2006-2016), a past President of the International Academy of Consumer and Commercial Law and a past Governor of the American Stock Exchange (2002-2005).
