

Kate McKune is the General Counsel at Park Community Credit Union, which she joined in 2017 after fifteen years in commercial litigation practice. Kate grew up in Danville, Kentucky, and attended Wake Forest University, where she graduated Phi Beta Kappa and summa.cum.laude, studying English and Politics. She then worked on Capitol Hill for a brief time, before attending law school at the University of Virginia. After a clerkship with Hon.
