James Rathmell is the General Counsel of Haun Ventures, a venture capital firm with over \$2 billion in assets under management that invests in frontier and decentralized technologies, including digital assets, cryptographic protocols, and cryptographic primitives. He joined Haun Ventures in January 2022 as part of the firm's founding team.

Prior to Haun Ventures, Mr. Rathmell served as Crypto Counsel at Andreessen Horowitz, where he collaborated closely with the crypto funds' Chief Operating Officer, Chief Regulatory Officer, Chief Policy Officer, and General Counsel on legal, regulatory, and policy strategy. Before that, he practiced law at Cooley LLP, advising venture capital firms, startups, and public companies on financings, capital markets transactions, regulatory matters, corporate governance, and SEC reporting. While at Cooley, he was a member of the firm's crypto working group.

Mr. Rathmell holds a J.D. from Stanford Law School and an M.B.A. from Stanford Graduate School of Business, where he was named an Arjay Miller Scholar. He earned his B.A. *summa cum laude* in Economics-Philosophy from Columbia University.
