



### **Acting Director, Office of Examination and Insurance**

Amanda Parkhill is the Acting Director of NCUA's Office of Examination and Insurance. In this role, she oversees the NCUA's examination and supervision program, which ensures the safety and soundness of the credit unions system and manages risk to the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund.
