Jason Somensatto is the Director of Policy at Coin Center, a leading nonprofit research and advocacy organization focused on cryptocurrency and decentralized technologies. Prior to joining Coin Center, he held senior roles in both the public and private sectors related to the legal and regulatory treatment of cryptocurrencies. Jason served at the Commodity Futures Trading Commission (CFTC) as Acting Director of LabCFTC and as an advisor to Chairman Rostin Behnam on digital asset policy. He also led North American public policy at Chainalysis, managing engagement with lawmakers and regulators across the region. Earlier in his career, Jason spent 14 years practicing law in private firms and in-house, focusing on financial regulation. He has been writing and commenting on the intersection of cryptocurrency and financial regulation since 2015.

Jason earned his J.D. from the George Washington University Law School and his B.A. in Foreign Affairs from the University of Virginia.
