Social Security Point of Order

1. At the end of Title V, add the following:

SEC. 5007. POINT OF ORDER AGAINST LEGISLATION THAT WOULD BREAK DONALD TRUMP'S PROMISE NOT TO CUT SOCIAL SECURITY

Point of Order. — It shall not be in order in the House to consider any bill, joint resolution, motion, amendment, amendment between the Houses, or conference report that would —

- (1) result in a reduction of guaranteed benefits scheduled under title II of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.);
- (2) increase either the early or full retirement age for the benefits described in paragraph (1); or
- (3) privatize Social Security.
