Current Contract:

1. Contract (#SUB-2022-10151) with the Alliance for Sustainable Energy, LLC (NREL) for \$100,001 to develop and produce an updated edition of the [EE Market Report](#) – it falls as a subcontract to DOE’s Prime Contract No. DE-AC36-08GO28308 with NREL.

Past Contract:

1. \$100,000 contract (#AGZ-9-92262-01) with the Alliance for Sustainable Energy, LLC through 12/19 to develop and produce the initial EE Market Report.
2. Contract (#7559865) with the Regents of the University of California (LBNL) for \$20,000 in 2020 to support development of DOE’s Grid-interactive Efficiency Buildings (GEB) Roadmap – it falls as a subcontract to DOE’s Prime Contract No. DE-AC02-05CH11231 with LBNL – Based on knowledge and belief, the contract was modified to extend into 2021 and provide an additional \$10,000 in funding.
