

IBM is a vendor -- competing for information technology business -- across the Federal Government, including the Legislative, Executive, and Judicial branches, as well as independent establishments and government corporations. Our contracts are numerous and vary at any given time. IBM's Federal business has been awarded a number of federal contracts since since October 2012, as either a prime or subcontractor. These contracts were principally for IT related services and in total represent less than 5% of IBM's 2012 revenue. IBM has contracts to provide products and services to several federal agencies including the US Department of Education.
