19	(3) include all wholesale, retail, subsidized, dis-

1 ness entities described in such subsection accept as 2 payment in full for items, products, services, or procedures such individuals or business entities furnish 3 4 to individual consumers. 5 Penalties.—The Secretary of Health and Human Services may investigate any and all individuals 6 or business entities that fail to comply with the require-8 ments of this section and may impose on such individuals or business entities civil fines, or other civil penalties, as 10 determined appropriate by the Secretary. 11 (d) Insurance Entity Described.—For purposes 12 of this section, an insurance entity includes a health insur-13 ance issuer with respect to the offering of health insurance coverage, including in the individual market and small and 14 15 large group market (as such terms are defined in section 2791 of the Public Health Service Act), a plan sponsor 16 with respect to the offering of a group health plan (as defined in such section 2791), and entities responsible for 18 the administration of governmental health plans (includ-19 ing the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services with re-20 21 spect to the Medicare program under title XVIII of the 22 Social Security Act, State agencies responsible for admin-23 istration of State plans under the Medicaid program under title XIX of such Act, or State child assistance plans

under the State Children's Health Insurance Program

- 2 Management with respect to the Federal Employees
- 3 Health Benefits Program under chapter 89 of title 5,
- 4 United States Code).
