available under this section may be provided to a
local educational agency unless in-person instruction
is available to all students at each of the public elementary and secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the local educational agency.

8 (2)EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNT.—Each 9 State that receives a grant under this section shall 10 establish an Education Savings Account for each 11 student enrolled in a public elementary or secondary 12 school served by a local educational agency that does 13 not meet the requirement described in paragraph 14 (1). From the funds that are prohibited from being provided to a local educational agency under para-15 16 graph (1), the State shall deposit a per-pupil 17 amount in each student's account. The State shall 18 provide each student with the funds in the student's

- 1 account, which the student shall use for educational
- 2 expenses.
