

## **Markup Action Summary**

## **December 12, 2023**

## The Chair called up the following measures separately:

- 1. <u>H.R. 6655</u> (**Rep. Foxx**) To amend and reauthorize the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
  - i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated ANS 01.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Omar (D-MN) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated <a href="MARMN\_066">OMARMN\_066</a>. Rep. Omar subsequently withdrew the amendment.
    - b. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated GOOD\_02. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a roll call vote of 14 yays and 30 nays.
    - c. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated <u>GOOD\_120</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 5 yays and 38 nays.
    - d. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated <u>GOOD\_121</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a roll call vote of 12 yays and 31 nays.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6655 was requested. H.R. 6655 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 44 yays and 1 nay.

- 2. <u>H.R. 6585</u> (Rep. Stefanik) To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to extend Federal Pell Grant eligibility to certain short-term workforce programs.
  - i. Rep. Foxx (R-NC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6585, designated ANS.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Jayapal (D-WA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6585, designated <u>JAYAPA\_081</u>. Rep. Jayapal subsequently withdrew the amendment.
    - b. Rep. Takano (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6585, designated <u>TAKANO\_052</u>. Rep. Takano subsequently withdrew the amendment.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6585 was requested. H.R. 6585 was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 37 yays and 8 nays.
- **3.** <u>H.J. Res. 98</u> (**Rep. James**) Providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the rule submitted by the National Labor Relations Board relating to "Standard for Determining Joint Employer Status."
  - i. H.J. Res. 98 passed by voice vote. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.J. Res. 98 was requested. H.J. Res. 98 was ordered favorably reported to the House, by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 25 yays and 20 nays.
- 4. <u>H.R. 3400</u> (**Rep. Good**) To amend the National Labor Relations Act to adjust the dollar thresholds for National Labor Relations Board jurisdiction over certain labor disputes, and for other purposes.
  - i. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 3400, designated <u>HR3400\_ANS</u>.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 3400 was requested. H.R. 3400 was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 23 yays and 20 nays.
