



# COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION & THE WORKFORCE

## Markup Action Summary

December 12, 2023

The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. **H.R. 6655 (Rep. Foxx)** To amend and reauthorize the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
  - i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated ANS\_01.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - a. Rep. Omar (D-MN) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated OMARMN\_066. Rep. Omar subsequently withdrew the amendment.
  - b. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated GOOD\_02. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a roll call vote of 14 yays and 30 nays.
  - c. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated GOOD\_120. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a roll call vote of 5 yays and 38 nays.
  - d. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6655, designated GOOD\_121. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a roll call vote of 12 yays and 31 nays.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6655 was requested. H.R. 6655 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a roll call vote of 44 yays and 1 nay.

2. **H.R. 6585 (Rep. Stefanik)** To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to extend Federal Pell Grant eligibility to certain short-term workforce programs.
    - i. Rep. Foxx (R-NC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6585, designated ANS.
      - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Jayapal (D-WA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6585, designated JAYAPA\_081. Rep. Jayapal subsequently withdrew the amendment.
    - b. Rep. Takano (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6585, designated TAKANO\_052. Rep. Takano subsequently withdrew the amendment.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6585 was requested. H.R. 6585 was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a roll call vote of 37 yays and 8 nays.
3. **H.J. Res. 98 (Rep. James)** Providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the rule submitted by the National Labor Relations Board relating to “Standard for Determining Joint Employer Status.”
    - i. H.J. Res. 98 passed by voice vote. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.J. Res. 98 was requested. H.J. Res. 98 was ordered favorably reported to the House, by a roll call vote of 25 yays and 20 nays.
4. **H.R. 3400 (Rep. Good)** To amend the National Labor Relations Act to adjust the dollar thresholds for National Labor Relations Board jurisdiction over certain labor disputes, and for other purposes.
    - i. Rep. Good (R-VA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 3400, designated HR3400\_ANS.
      - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 3400 was requested. H.R. 3400 was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a roll call vote of 23 yays and 20 nays.
