

## **Markup Action Summary**

## H.R. 6951, the *College Cost Reduction Act*January 31, 2024

## The Chair called up the following measures separately:

<u>H.R. 6951</u> (**Rep. Foxx**) To lower the cost of postsecondary education for students and families.

- i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>H6951\_ANS</u>.
  - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - 1. Rep. Hayes (D-CT) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_01</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_01\_was included in amendment En Bloc #1, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 17 yays and 22 nays.
  - 2. Rep. Hayes offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_026</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_026 was included in amendment En Bloc #2, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 18 yays and 22 nays.
  - 3. Rep. Hayes offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <a href="https://HAYECT\_062">HAYECT\_062</a>. The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. HAYECT\_062 was included in amendment En Bloc #3, which failed by a roll call vote of 18 yays and 22 nays.

- 13. Rep. Takano (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_08</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_08 failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- 14. Rep. Takano offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_027</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_027 was included in amendment En Bloc #4, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- 15. Rep. Adams (D-NC) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_016</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_016 failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.

The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. - 17. Rep. Sablan (D-MP) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <a href="SABLAN\_033">SABLAN\_033</a>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. SABLAN\_033 was included in amendment En Bloc #5, which failed by a <a href="roll-call-vote">roll-call-vote</a> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- 18. Rep. McBath (D-GA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_11</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_11 was included in amendment En Bloc #4, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- 19. Rep. Bonamici (D-OR) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_015</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_015 failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 21 nays.

The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_022 was included in amendment En Bloc #3, which failed by a <a href="roll call vote">roll call vote</a> of 18 yays and 22 nays.
- 24. Rep. Omar offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_014</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_014 failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- 25. Rep. Omar offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <a href="MARMN\_067">OMARMN\_067</a>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. OMARMN\_067 was included in amendment En Bloc #3, which failed by a roll call vote of 18 yays and 22 nays.
- 26. Rep. Omar offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <a href="OMARMN\_068">OMARMN\_068</a>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. OMARMN\_068 was included in amendment En Bloc #3, which failed by a roll call vote of 18 yays and 22 nays.
- 27. Rep. Bowman (D-NY) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated DAMD 019. The amendment failed

- by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_019 was included in amendment En Bloc #2, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 18 yays and 22 nays.
- 28. Rep. Bowman offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_033</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_033 was included in amendment En Bloc #2, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 18 yays and 22 nays.
- 29. Rep. Manning (D-NC) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_10</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_10 was included in amendment En Bloc #4, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- 30. Rep. Manning offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_018</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_018 failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 20 yays and 21 nays.
- 31. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6951, designated <u>DAMD\_021</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. DAMD\_021was included in amendment En Bloc #4, which failed by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 19 yays and 22 nays.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6951, as amended, was requested. H.R. 6951, as amended, was ordered favorably reported to the House by a <u>roll call vote</u> of 22 yays and 19 nays.
