## The Chair called up the following measures separately:

- 1. <u>H.R. 3453</u> (Rep. Letlow) A bill to modify the program of grants to support high-quality charter schools.
  - i. Rep. Letlow (R-LA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 3453, designated <u>3453ANS\_01</u>.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Bonamici (D-OR) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 3453, designated <u>BONAMI\_036</u>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a <u>recorded vote</u> of 15 yeas and 19 nays.
    - b. Ranking Member Bobby Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 3453, designated <a href="SCOTVA\_029">SCOTVA\_029</a>. The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a recorded vote of 15 yeas and 20 nays.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 3453 as amended was requested. H.R. 3453 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a recorded vote of 20 yeas and 15 nays.

- 2. <u>H.R. 2516 (Rep. Owens)</u> A bill to amend the *Higher Education Act of 1965* to prohibit political litmus tests in accreditation of institutions of higher education, and for other purposes.
  - i. Rep. Owens (R- UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2516, designated HR2516ANS 01.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 2516 as amended was requested. H.R. 2516 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a <u>recorded vote</u> of 21 yeas and 15 nays.
- **3.** <u>H.R. 4054 (Rep. Fine)</u> A bill to amend the *Higher Education Act of 1965* to reform accreditation.
  - i. Rep. Fine (R-FL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4054, designated <u>HR4054ANS 01</u>.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 4054 as amended was requested. H.R. 4054 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a recorded vote of 21 yeas and 15 nays.
- 4. <u>H.R. 2528 (Rep. Walberg)</u> A bill to amend the *Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974* to clarify the treatment of certain association health plans as employers, and for other purposes.
  - i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2528, designated HR2528 ANS A.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 2528 as amended was requested. H.R. 2528 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a <u>recorded</u> vote of 21 yeas and 15 nays.
- 5. <u>H.R. 2988 (Rep. Allen)</u> A bill to amend the *Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974* to specify requirements concerning the consideration of pecuniary and non-pecuniary factors, and for other purposes.
  - i. Rep. Allen (R-GA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2988, designated <u>H2988 ANS</u>.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 2988 as amended was requested. H.R. 2988 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a recorded vote of 21 yeas and 15 nays.

- 6. <u>H.R. 2571 (Rep. Onder)</u> A bill to amend *the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974* to exclude from the definition of health insurance coverage certain medical stop-loss insurance obtained by certain plan sponsors of group health plans, and for other purposes.
  - i. Rep. Onder (R-MO) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2571, designated HR2571 ANS.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 2571 as amended was requested. H.R. 2571 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a recorded vote of 21 yeas and 15 nays.
- 7. <u>H.R. 3170 (Rep. Walberg)</u> A bill to amend chapter 81 of title 5, United States Code, to cover, for purposes of workers' compensation under such chapter, services by physician assistants and nurse practitioners provided to injured Federal workers, and for other purposes.
  - i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 3170, designated HR3170 ANS.
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 3170 as amended was requested. H.R. 3170 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a <u>recorded vote</u> of 34 yeas and 0 nays.
