The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. [H.R. 6359 \(Rep. Hinson\)](#) A bill to require institutions of higher education to disseminate information on the rights of, and accommodations and resources for, pregnant students, and for other purposes.
 - i. Rep. Miller (R-IL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6359, designated [HR6359 ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Bonamici (D-OR) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6359, designated [BONAMICI_AMD_01](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 13 yeas and 21 nays.
 - b. Rep. Stevens (D-MI) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6359, designated [STEVENS_AMD_03](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a [recorded vote](#) was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a recorded vote of 15 yeas and 21 nays.
 - c. Rep. Lee (D-PA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6359, designated [LEE_AMD_02](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a [recorded vote](#) was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a recorded vote of 15 yeas and 21 nays.
 - d. Rep. Omar (D-MN) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6359, designated [OMAR_AMD_05](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a [recorded vote](#) was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a recorded vote of 15 yeas and 21 nays.

- e. Rep. Wilson (D-FL) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6359, designated [WILSON_AMD_04](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a [recorded vote](#) was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a recorded vote of 15 yeas and 21 nays.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6359 as amended was requested. H.R. 6359 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 21 yeas and 15 nays.
2. **H.R. 4307 (Rep. Walberg)** A bill to direct the Secretary of Labor to train certain employees of Department of Labor how to effectively detect and assist law enforcement in preventing human trafficking during the course of their official duties, and for other purposes.
- i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4307, designated [HR4307_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. DeSaulnier (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4307, designated [DESAULNIER_AMD_02_2026](#). This amendment was withdrawn.
 - b. Rep. Adams (D-NC) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4307, designated [ADAMS_AMD_ADAMNC_564](#). This amendment was withdrawn.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 4307 as amended was requested. H.R. 4307 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 36 yeas and 0 nays.
