



Markup Action Summary January 21, 2026

The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. [H.R. 7082 \(Rep. Mackenzie\)](#) A bill to amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 in order to provide for greater flexibility in the Federal programs supporting the planning and implementation of charter schools.
 - i. Rep. Mackenzie (R-PA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7082, designated [HR7082 ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Bonamici (D-OR) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7082, designated as [BONAMI 069](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas to 18 nays.
 - b. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7082, designated as [SCOTVA 051](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas to 19 nays.
 - c. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7082, designated as [SCOTT GAO 01](#). The amendment failed by voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas to 19 nays.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7082 as amended was requested. H.R. 7082 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 19 yeas and 15 nays.

2. **H.R. 7086 (Rep. Ciscomani)** A bill to support the creation and implementation of State policies, as well as the expansion of existing State policies, for improving the quality and affordability of charter school facilities and to authorize the provision of technical assistance to support the growth and expansion of high-quality charter schools.
 - i. Rep. Kiley (R-CA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7086, designated [HR7086_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Norcross (D-NJ) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7086, designated [NORCRO_035](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 16 yeas to 18 nays.
 - b. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7086, designated [SCOTT_AMD_01](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas to 19 nays.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7086 as amended was requested. H.R. 7086 was ordered favorably to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 19 yeas and 15 nays.

3. **H.R. 4624 (Rep. Jack)** A bill to amend the Professional Boxing Safety Act of 1996 to establish requirements for unified boxing organizations, to further enhance the wellbeing of professional boxers, and for other purposes.
 - i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4624, designated [HR4624_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Harris (R-NC) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4624, designated [HARRNC_034](#). The amendment passed by a voice vote.
 - b. Rep. Omar (D-MN) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4624, designated [OMAR_AND4624_05](#). The amendment passed by a voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 4624 as amended was requested. H.R. 4624 was ordered favorably to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 30 yeas and 4 nays.
