1. [H.R. 7720 \(Rep. Messmer\)](#) A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to require States to account for fraudulent payments made under such Act.
  - i. Rep. Messmer (R-IN) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7720, designated [H7720 ANS](#).
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - b. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7720, designated [SCOTT H7720AM 004](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 19 nays.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7720 as amended was requested. H.R. 7720 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 19 yeas and 15 nays.
2. [H.R. 7721 \(Rep. Grothman\)](#) A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to implement an improper payment threshold under such Act.

3. **H.R. 7722 (Rep. Onder)** A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to require triennial comprehensive reviews of State performance under such Act.

    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - a. Rep. DeSaulnier (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7722, designated [DESAULNIER\\_H7722AM\\_004](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 19 nays.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7722 as amended was requested. H.R. 7722 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 19 yeas and 15 nays.
4. **H.R. 7723 (Rep. Foxx)** A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to debar child care providers that committed fraud from receiving financial assistance under the Act, and for other purposes.
- i. Rep. Foxx (R-NC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7723, designated [PROVIDER\\_ANS\\_01](#).
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7723, designated [SCOTT\\_H7723AM\\_002](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 20 nays.

- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7723 as amended was requested. H.R. 7723 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 20 yeas and 15 nays.
5. **H.R. 7724 (Rep. Wilson)** A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to sustain sanctions against noncompliant State under such Act.
  - i. Rep. Wilson (R-SC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7724, designated [H7724\\_ANS](#).
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7724, designated [SCOTT\\_H7724AM\\_001](#). The amendment was withdrawn.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7724 as amended was requested. H.R. 7724 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 20 yeas and 15 nays.
6. **H.R. 7725 (Rep. Rulli)** A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to require States disclose agency regulatory participation under such Act.
  - i. Rep. Rulli (R-OH) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7725, designated [H7725\\_ANS](#).
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Lee (D-PA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7725, designated [LEE\\_H7725AM\\_005](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 20 nays.
  - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7725 as amended was requested. H.R. 7725 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 35 yeas and 0 nays.
7. **H.R. 7677 (Rep. Owens)** A bill to require the Comptroller General of the United States to conduct a study regarding fraud prevention measures in certain Federal early childhood education, child care, and child nutrition programs, and for other purposes
  - i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7677, designated [GAO\\_ANS\\_01](#).
    - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
    - a. Rep. Mannion (D-NY) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7677, designated [MANNION\\_AMD\\_02](#). The

amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 20 nays.

- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7677 as amended was requested. H.R. 7677 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 35 yeas and 0 nays.

8. **H.R. 7726 (Rep. Miller)** A bill to amend the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to withhold funds from noncompliant States under such Act.

- i. Rep. Miller (R-IL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7726, designated [H7726 ANS](#).
  - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
  - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7726, designated [SCOTT H7726AM.1](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 16 yeas and 19 nays.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7726 as amended was requested. H.R. 7726 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 20 yeas and 15 nays.
