Agenda:

- [H.R. 8210, A Stronger Workforce for America Act](#)

Business Meeting: Prior to the consideration of legislation, the Chair moved to confirm Rep. Kevin Kiley as the Chair of the Subcommittee on Early Childhood, Elementary, and Secondary Education and as a member of the Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Development.

The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. **H.R. 8210 (Rep. Walberg)** A bill to reauthorize the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
 - i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8210, designated [ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8210, designated [SCOTT_SAMD_01](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 14 yeas and 18 nays.
 - b. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8210, designated [SCOTT_RA_GRANT_AMD](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 14 yeas and 19 nays.
