The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. **H.R. 8736 (Rep. Grothman)** A bill to amend the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 to ensure workplace choice and opportunity for young adults with disabilities.
 - i. Rep. Grothman (R-WI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8736, designated [ANS8736_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8736, designated [SCOTVA_063](#). The amendment was withdrawn.
 - b. Rep. McBath (D-GA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8736, designated [MCBATH_AMD_EMPTYA](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8736 as amended was requested. H.R. 8736 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.
2. **H.R. 8705 (Rep. Owens)** A bill to amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to prevent the American History and Civics program from funding radical indoctrination, and for other purposes.

- i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8705, designated [MU8705ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Bonamici (D-OR) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8705, designated [BONAMI_100](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 19 nays.

3. **H.R. 7362 (Rep. Grothman)** A bill to amend the Employment Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to simplify the filing of form 5500 for employee benefit plan administrators.
 - i. Rep. Grothman (R-WI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7362, designated [HR7362_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7362 as amended was requested. H.R. 7362 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 22 yeas and 12 nays.

4. **H.R. 7895 (Rep. Allen)** A bill to amend section 408 of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to prohibit kickbacks to pharmacy benefit managers.
- i. Rep. Allen (R-GA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7895, designated [HR7895_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. DeSaulnier (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 7895, designated [DESAULNIER_HR7895_AMD_1](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 19 nays.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 7895 as amended was requested. H.R. 7895 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 34 yeas and 0 nays.
5. **H.R. 8684 (Rep. Foxx)** A bill to amend the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to require group health plans and health insurance issuers offering group health insurance coverage to only pay claims submitted by hospitals that have in place policies and procedures to ensure accurate billing practices and for other purposes.
- i. Rep. Foxx (R-NC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8684, designated [HR8684_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8684 as amended was requested. H.R. 8684 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 34 yeas and 0 nays.
